PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

From Johnson George Spring
Through Johnson George Pipe line
J. C. Pagnoni

the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by himself and his predecessors in interest are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(1) Name of claimant J. C. Pagnoni
Address Duckwater, County of Nye

(2) The means of diversion employed is small dam, small reservoir and pipe line

(3) The water is impounded in small reservoir and wooden trough

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun at least prior to 1900 and completed the same year it was commenced

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is possessory

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of County, at Page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 25, and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 365 days during each of the following months every month of the year. This use was made by Johnson George, claimant's predecessor in interest and was continued by him during the whole of each year, watering about 25 or 30 animals continuously until the winter of 1906 and 1907, when claimant bought John George's interest.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

During 1907 about thirty or ~~forty~~ forty  
During 1908 and in all subsequent years to and  
including 1916 claimant has watered thirty or  
forty animals more or less (the number  
varying from time to time) at said Johnson  
George Spring

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been  
about one-fortieth of a cubic foot per second.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at <sup>approximately</sup> South 25 degrees West, 27000 feet from  
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance  
the South corner of Section 5, 33<sup>rd</sup> 34<sup>th</sup> T. 12 N., R. 56 E.,  
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at the Spring  
Describe as within 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: There is no other spring of water within  
five miles of Johnson George Spring.
