PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

From McCure Spring Name of natural water course  
Through McCure Spring Pipe Line Name of ditch, pipe line, etc.

J. C. Pagnoni, the undersigned, being first  
duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of  
water by him are full and correct to the  
best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(2) The means of diversion employed is an iron pipe line, two inches in diameter  
Name of ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in a small reservoir and an iron tank  
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun in 1906  
and completed the same year; but the Spring has been used by claimant  
for watering livestock since 1886

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is Possessory

(6) The claimant's water right ~~was~~ (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of  
County, at Page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year <sup>1886</sup> was about 20,  
and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 365 days during each  
~~of the following months~~ of the year

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

From 1886 to 1887 from twenty to fifty; in 1889 about 75; from 1889 to 1905 the number gradually increased from about 75 in 1889 to about 150 in 1905. In 1906 claimant developed the spring by sinking therein and running a trench, constructed a reservoir and ran the water from there by pipe line to an iron tank about 200 feet distant. In 1906 and in each subsequent year claimant has watered about 400 animals at this spring.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been one-sixteenth of an cubic feet per second.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at \_\_\_\_\_ feet from the \_\_\_\_\_ corner of Section \_\_\_\_\_, T. \_\_\_\_\_, R. \_\_\_\_\_ E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

(11) The works are located at the spring

Remarks:

(10) The water is diverted from the spring <sup>on unimproved land</sup> and bears south 52 degrees 10-minutes west from what is known as Big Warm Spring near Duckwater Creek, is about seven miles distant. There is <sup>other</sup> no flowing spring of water within four miles of McClure Spring. The Big Warm Spring above mentioned is located in the NW 1/4 of Section 32, T. 13 N. R. 5 E. M. D. B. + M.
