PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

From MOODY SPRING
Through Moody Spring pipe line.
J. C. Tognoni, the undersigned, being first

duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by him are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(1) Name of claimant J. C. TOGNONI
Address Duckwater, County of Nye
State of Nevada.

(2) The means of diversion employed is a pipe line

(3) The water is impounded in a reservoir and in a wooden trough.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun in 1900 and completed the same year.

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is possessory

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Nye County at Page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 75 and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 365 days

of the following months during the year. The animals were ranging in the vicinity and watered at other springs as well as Moody Springs, and it is not probable that they all watered at Moody Spring during each day of the year.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

The number has varied from about seventy-five to as many as three hundred during each of the years subsequent to the year 1900, down to and including the year 1916.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

$\frac{1}{20}$ cubic feet per second.
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at (SEE BELOW) feet from the corner of Section , T. , R. E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Note: Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at the springs.
Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks:

(10) The water is diverted from the spring, which bears approximately North 74° West about fifteen miles from what is known as the Big Warm Spring situate in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 32, T. 13 N., R. 56 E., M.D.B. & M., near Duckwater in Nye County, Nevada. Moody Spring is situate on the westerly slope of the Pancake Range of Mountains, and there is no other spring on the westerly slope of that range except a small spring fed by snowwater about six miles north of Moody Spring.
Moody Spring is on unsurveyed land.
