During May, June, July, August, September and October of each year from 1887 to 1897 inclusive J. W. Adams watered from 500 to 1000 range cattle, from 1898 to 1910 inclusive Adams and McGill (a partnership) watered from 100 to 1000 cattle and up to 5000 sheep, from 1911 on the Adams-McGill Company Inc. watered from 100 to 1000 cattle and 5000 sheep from this and other springs in vicinity.
