Remarks: The principal method of irrigation is by means of flooding and red top, rye grass and blue joint hay have been grown. It is proposed to put in drain ditches and raise alfalfa.

During late years and prior to the earthquake there has not been less an water every year an account of S. Siard & Pearce ranch putting in more land and using water on same, regardless of the prior rights of lands owned by Cooper and Unacke. Since the earthquake there has been more water and we have made a new application for said earthquake water so as to put in alfalfa.
