Reno Natl bank went into receivership during the depression and unpatented state contracts covered by this application reverted back to the state of Nevada as witnessed by the enclosed copies to the state contract application file payment schedule. (SEE ENCLOSED ABSTRACT) It is our position that the water remained appurtenant to the land and title passed into the State of Nevada and out to the new applicant to which we are successors in title. The patented portion of this application was sold for taxes by Pershing county and title passed in succession to our predecessors. Paris Bros has been in quiet possession and exclusive users since 1945.
