(19) The map provided by the ~~State Engineer~~ and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditch lines or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: none

(21) The character of the soil is sandy loam (Sandy, gravelly, loam) The soil needs one acre-foot per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of one cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of six months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

Remarks: The waters from Snow Creek were appropriated by claimant's predecessors in interest as early as 1873 but the records in the office of the County Recorder of Elko County show that the particular ditch conveying water to the above described land was constructed April 2, 1888. And the records in the Office of the County Clerk of Elko County show that there was an adjudication of this water right, together with others and a decree entered by the District Court of said Elko County about the year 1881, decreeing to one Joseph W. Jerrett all of the water from Snow Creek to be used to irrigate the above described lands as well as other lands, and Joseph W. Jerrett is one of the claimant's predecessors in interest.
