(21) The character of the soil is sandy loam The soil needs acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(22) Remarks: Dams, ditches and laterals were constructed at an early date and water has been used continuously. Applicant does not know exact acreage in cultivation as cultural map has not been made at present time. Cultural map will be made and forwarded to State Engineer at earliest possible date.
