

PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

From Summit Spring
Name of natural water course

Through Pipe line and troughs.
Name of ditch, pipe line, etc.

Ambro Rosaschi, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by himself and predecessors are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(2) The means of diversion employed is Pipe line and troughs
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in Troughs.
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun in 1886
and completed in 1886

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is
no title (unsurveyed)

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of
Esmeralda County, at Page 55 of Book C of Pre-emption records

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 1500,
head of cattle
and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30 days during each
of the following months : the entire year.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

0.025 cubic feet per second.
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at S. $41^{\circ} 38'$ E. 2007 feet from
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance
the W. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. ~~8~~ corner of Section 18, T. 11 N., R. 28 E.,
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, probably in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 18, above T. & R.

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 5 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at the spring.
Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: This Spring, together with a number of others, as filed upon under applications Nos. 5282, 5283, 5286, and 5287, was originally located and used by J. E. Gignoux, as shown by his recorded claim under date of 1886, copy of which is attached hereto. The claimant herein is the predecessor in interest of the rights of Mr. Gignoux, and when the property was purchased by the said claimant in 1910, there were two very old troughs at the springs. The claimant herein is contemplating the placing of additional troughs at the spring in question, and for this purpose, and in order to fully insure his protection under the water laws of Nevada, has filed application No. 5285 for the waters of this source.

The exact number of cattle watered at the spring is not known but claimant's predecessor ran about 1500 head of cattle in the vicinity of the spring.
