the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by The Adams-McGill Company are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

(1) Name of claimant The Adams-McGill Company
Address Ely, County of White Pine, State of Nevada

(2) The means of diversion employed is iron pipe 120 feet long

(3) The water is impounded in iron troughs

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun about the year 1900 and completed the present improvements in June, 1919.

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is possessory land not yet surveyed

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of White Pine County, at Page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 3,000, and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of full month days during each of the following months April, May, June, July, August, September and October

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

about 3,000 head of sheep are daily watered at these troughs, and fifty head of cattle per day.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

(1) one-fourth cubic feet per second.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at the spring ~~feet from~~

True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

in the NW¹/₄ of NW¹/₄ corner of Section 15, T. 18N., R. 62E.,
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 5 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at near the spring in NW¹/₄ of SW¹/₄, Sec 15, T 18N.,
R 62E.
Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: This spring was purchased 28 years ago from Thomas Short by the Adams-McGill Company. Prior to this, Short had used the spring for a number of years. Since the Adams-McGill Company purchased this spring, it has been constantly in use for watering stock by The Adams-McGill Company. The Adams-McGill Company put in one hundred feet of wooden troughs about ten years ago; these recently gave out, and we have now put in fifty feet of iron troughs.
