From GRAVEL SPRING.

Name of natural water course

Through Small dam and reservoir.

Name of ditch, pipe line, etc.

Albert Rosenlund, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by him are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(1) Name of claimant Albert Rosenlund, Address Schellbourne, County of White Pine, State of Nevada.

(2) The means of diversion employed is

Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in Small dam and reservoir.

Froughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun in 1900, and completed August, 1919.

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is Possessory right upon unsurveyed public land.

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of County, at Page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 1800 sheep and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30 days during each of the following months April, May, June, September, October and November.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

About 1800 sheep in 1900 and until about 4 years ago, when 2000 sheep were watered at this spring, and about 2200 the following year, and they have increased until this year when 3000 sheep have been watered at this spring in the usual way of ranging and grazing the flock.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

one miners inch cubic feet per second.
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at N. 31° 20' W., 24,864 feet from
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance
the North West corner of Section 5, T. 23N., R. 66 E.,
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at the spring in the SW¹/₄ of the SE¹/₄, Sec. 11, T. 24N., R. 65E., unsurveyed.
Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: This spring was first used by Casten Olsen in 1900 for watering his sheep and cattle and the land owned by him and his range rights were purchased by the applicant in 1906 and have been used exclusively by him since that time. It is one or a series of small springs, and while it alone is not sufficient to water a large herd, by combining the several springs together and ranging the herd from one to the other, a good sized flock may be watered. Each year the applicant has cleaned out the springs and repaired the works so as to make them better suited for stock watering purposes.
