PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

Leo C. Winder, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by Murray Sheep Company are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

Said undersigned is the Secretary of claimant.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(2) The means of diversion employed is Dam and ditch
not not Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded ~~is~~ but flows in ditch.
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun and

and completed in 1884, but stock watering commenced later, the exact time being unknown to claimant but it was several years prior to 1898.

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is none other than range right

(6) The claimant's water right ~~was~~ (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of _____ County, at Page _____ of Book _____ of _____'s predecessors

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant/during the first year was about 3000 and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30 days during each of the following months March, April, May, September, October and November.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant/in subsequent years was as follows: in 1903, about 3000 head of sheep. Subsequently every year to and including the Fall of 1908 about 3000 head of sheep during each of said months; and also from 50 to 100 head of cattle during every month of each of said years. From 1909 up to the present time claimant has watered approximately 3000 head of sheep during each of said months of each year and also more than 100 head of cattle and about 20 head of burrows during every month of each of said years.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been two and one-half cubic feet per second.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at Easterly about 500 feet from the Big Spring at the head of the stream which bears S. 8° E. 1240 ft. from the North quarter corner of Section 33, T. 10 N., R. 70 E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: There are no works other than the dam and ditch. The stock are and at all times herein mentioned have been watered from the ditch at points covering a distance of about three miles, in the $W\frac{1}{2}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$, $S\frac{1}{2}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$, $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$, of Section fifteen, and the $E\frac{1}{2}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, all in T. 10 N., R. 70 E., M.D.B. & M. but chiefly at points in the $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$, $S\frac{1}{2}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$ and $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$, of Section 11, and $W\frac{1}{2}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$, $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ and $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, all in T. 10 N., R. 70 E., M.D.B. & M.

The water was first used as above set forth for several years prior to 1898 by Messrs. W.L. Jones and John Alcock. They used the water up to 1903 when they sold to W.O. Packard and H.E. Lisonbee. Messrs. Packard and Lisonbee so used the water until 1909 when they sold to claimant.

Remarks: The greater part of the stock are watered as far North in the ditch as the water will run. This was done and is particularly desirable in order to reach the valuable range to the North.
