Charles Smith, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by him and his predecessors in interest are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: domestic and watering live stock

(21) The character of the soil is 130.9 acres loam, 29.9 / <sup>sandy</sup> The soil needs ..... acre-feet  
(Sandy, gravelly, loam)  
per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of 1.555 cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of 7 months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(22) Remarks: The soil is shallow, varying from six inches to three and one-half feet in depth, and is underlaid by a stratum of impervious hard pan. The surface and the hard pan slope upward from the westerly side of said Lake Creek, which is the side of the said stream on which the water is so used for irrigation. The water used for irrigation on this land percolates rapidly through the soil to the hard pan and then drains along the top of the hard pan back into the channel of Lake Creek. This condition results in the requirement of a large quantity of water for irrigation, but on the other hand it assures the relatively prompt return to the stream of substantially all of the water used.
