Remarks: Water naturally drains into a lake or pond about three or
four acres in area. This lake is commonly known as "Dry Lake"
and is about 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ miles north of Mt. Hicks and about four miles
east of Aurora. T. C. Sharpe used the water of this lake for
stockwatering continuously from 1892 to 1918, and L. A. L. Green
used the same from 1895 to 1918 for the same purpose. The rights
of both parties in the premises have now been purchased by the
Allied Land and Livestock Co., claimant herein.

The amount of water which has been used as near as can be ~~xxxxxx~~
estimated at this time is 20 acre feet. The water generally lasts
to August 1st and sometimes September 1st.

Attached hereto are affidavits of L. A. L. Green and T. C.
Sharpe in support of the claim herein made.
