PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 200 head of sheep

and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of Nov. 1st to June 1st

and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of Nov. 1st to June 1st during each year, the number of days cannot be stated.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

In the year 1895 200 head of sheep were watered at the spring, approximately the same number watered each year up to the year 1914 when 1000 head were watered, in the year 1919 the number was increased to 1500.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

one fortieth cubic feet per second.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

Remarks: The claimant first developed the water in the year 1895, by cleaning out the spring, and turning the water into cuts, by means of ditches, for the convenient watering of sheep. In the year 1914 the spring was further developed by sinking a shaft therein and installing a pipe leading from the bottom of shaft to troughs. A small reservoir created by the shaft in the spring conserves the water for use in the troughs. Application and Permit No. 5378 is filed in Office of State Engineer of Nevada by above claimant to cover water of springs over and above that which he claims as vested right in this proof.

Remarks: That water has been gradually developed and at all times since 1895 all the water developed in the said spring has been used during the grazing season by this claimant for stock watering purposes and by virtue of said water right.
