(21) The character of the soil is loam, steep, and gravelly. The soil needs 3 to 4 acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of 9 months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(22) Remarks: This water right was first used by John Schell in the year or about 1895, or before the year 1896

This main Spring lies in the SE 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 30, Tp 30, N.R. 40 E. M.D.B.M. The spring is not placed on the map, it being too far below the border.

The ditch as shown as leading from the spring now shown on map was built about 1895 or before.

It is next to impossible to determine the acreage irrigated under each ditch, as the waters from one ditch flows into an other and is used again, ..
