The map supporting 01704 showed all of the acres irrigated as of 1918 (except for the NW¹/₄ section 2), but the Certificate, for some reason did not show it. This may be because of Cert. 01262 and its map, of which is in complete error. I am submitting affidavits from leading citizens of a few years back, and of whom are mostly now deceased who certify of the validity of the irrigated lands of this ranch.

I am also submitting an ammended map of a portion of the ranch which was discounted at the time because it was in Gov't ownership. I have now got a patent on that property under the unintentional trespass act.

I am also showing a new places of diversion as a part of the ammendment, because the flooding in Meadow Valley Wash has made the channel much deeper, necessitating these changes.

I have deeds from the original owners prior to 1900 to the present time showing all transfers .

The undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by James B. Tennille, Jr. are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.


