As a means of explanation it is desired to state that there is no clearly defined channel of the creek in many places. The point of diversion of this ditch (No. 1) is at the point designated on the map in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 8, T. 8 N. R. 25 E., M.D. B & M., at which point natural channel is not well defined but water is spread over the land by means of a number of small ditches, Ditch No. 1 being the principal ditch. Water from the irrigation of the land east of the lane is collected in the channel which crosses the lane and used on a portion of the land below the said lane. Land east of lane is very swampy.
