(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: stock purposes

(21) The character of the soil is clay and sandy loam. The soil needs 3 acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of 6 cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of 3 months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(22) Remarks: Some years the Reese River has considerable water; others, very little. Use water as long as it flows in stream, which is generally about to June 1st.
