(19) The map provided by the State Engineer and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditch lines or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: stock watering and domestic purposes.

(21) The character of the soil is loam (Sandy, gravelly, loam) The soil needs 3 acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(22) Remarks: All of the water herein claimed has been used for irrigation stock watering and domestic purposes, each and every year since the year 1897 to my own personal knowledge.
