(21) The character of the soil is Sandy Loam The soil needs 3 acre-feet  
(Sandy, gravelly, loam)  
per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of 1 cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of          months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(22) Remarks: All of the above described land has been irrigated since 1892 and there has been no change in the irrigated lands since that time.

Ditch # 1 irrigates approximately 4 acres; 2.1 acres in the N. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the N. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  and 2 acres in the S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the N. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  in Sec. 35.

Ditch # 2 irrigates approximately 5 acres; 4  $\frac{1}{2}$  acres in the N. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the N. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  and  $\frac{1}{2}$  acres in the S. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the N. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 35.

*Sec. map* Ditch # 3 irrigates approximately 4 acres; 2 acres in the S. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the N. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  and 2 acres in the N. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the S.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$ , in Sec. 34.

*S. E.* Ditch # 4 irrigates approximately 2.5 acres; .07 acres in the S. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the N. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  and 1.8 acres in the N. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the S. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 34.
