Matter Handley, the undersigned, being first
duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of
water by Handley Bros. are full and correct to the
best of his knowledge and belief.

Deponent and his brother, Isaac T. Handley
are a partnership known as Handley Bros.
If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

claimants (and their predecessors) have watered

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

(10) The water is diverted from its source at about 400 ft. from center of North Boundary line
Tide bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance feet from

Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Remarks:

Claimants own a large ranch most of which is patented land - also some old government contract land. They took by deed from Henry Medelind, who in turn took from Nick Ratto, and this water has been used by them for 35 or 40 years for stock watering.

This Spring rises in part of swampy place and spreads over small area where cattle can drink it. The depressions that hold the water are natural ones.
