best of his knowledge and belief.

(1) Name of claimant H.F. Powell

(2) The means of diversion employed is 20' of 1 1/2" pipe.  
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in reservoir at spring, also trough  
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun prior to 1902  
and completed prior to 1902.

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is  
Possessory.

(6) The claimant's water right was (~~was not~~) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of  
Lyon County, at Page 306 of Book B of survey records.

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 500 sheep  
and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 15 days during each  
of ~~the following~~ the following months of the year.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:  
approximately 500 sheep.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been  
.01 cubic feet per second.  
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at S.17°10' W.5020 feet from  
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance  
the S.W. corner of Section 21, T. 16 N., R. 22 E.,  
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Note—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the S.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. 29 T. 16 N., R. 22 E. (M-SURVEY)  
Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: This spring is used in conjunction with Fiddlers Green Spring No. 1. There is not sufficient water in this spring to accomodate a large band of sheep, so that it is used for watering small bands of sheep and for camp water.

There is an excavation 4' x 6' x 4' deep at the spring, which serves as a reservoir, from which water is conveyed through a 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " pipe 20' long to a trough 14' long, 12" wide and 10" deep.
