Remarks: This water is first diverted and used in a reservoir at S.48°10'W.9250 ft. from the NW. Cor. of Sec. 7, T. 21 N. R. 69 E. then taken from same channel into a reservoir at S.47°W.9400 ft. from some corner, and at S.44°30'W.10,000 ft. from same corner it is diverted into a ditch and conveyed through it for watering purposes in a Southerly direction for a distance of 2800 ft.

Answer to question 4; A small reservoir built by J.R. Ferry at some time unknown to deponent, occupied approximately the same position as the first of the above mentioned reservoirs. The new reservoirs and ditch ~~were~~ started in 1917 and completed in 1920.

Remarks: Prior to ~~the~~ completion of improvements use of water was made by watering stock in natural channels; this in fact is most satisfactory manner to use the water when there is sufficient.
