best of his knowledge and belief.

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 500
and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30 days during each
of the following months all the months of the year

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

About 500 head of cattle and horses were watered at these springs

by J.R. Ferry ^{since from 1885} until about 1915 since that date E.A. and Fred Henriod have watered about 100 head of cattle and 2500 sheep.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been approx 0.02 ^{40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second} cubic feet per second.

(10) The water is diverted from its source at see under remarks below feet from the corner of Section T, R, E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at see under remarks below

Remarks: The sources of this water are two springs the first is located S.54°15'W. 5350 ft. from the NW. Cor. of Sec. 7, T. 21 N. R. 69 E. and the second at S.53°20'W. 6520 ft. from the same corner. The water of the first spring flows through natural channel into the second spring and there combined and used first in 6 troughs which bear S.53°20'W. 6570 ft. from said corner, then used in a reservoir which bears S.53°45'W. 6700 ft. from same corner; then in another reservoir which bears S.54°20'W. 7150 ft. from same corner and again used in 4 troughs which bears S.53°45'W. 7670 ft. from same corner.

In addition to its use at specified points the water is used at its sources and along the natural channels.

Answer to Question 4; A small reservoir built by J.R. Ferry ~~occupied~~ at a period unknown to deponent, ~~was~~ occupied the location of the first reservoir above mentioned. The above reservoirs and troughs were built and placed between 1916 and the present date.
