(2) The means of diversion employed is dams and reservoir.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun 1900,  
and completed August, 1919.

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is Possessory right upon unsurveyed public land.

(6) The claimant's water right was ~~was~~ not recorded in the office of the County Recorder of County, at Page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 1800 sheep, and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30 days during each of the following months April to November, both inclusive.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

1800 head of sheep each year from 1900 to 1915;

2000 head of sheep in 1916;

2200 head of sheep in 1917;

3000 head in each of the years 1918 and 1919; and

3600 head of sheep in 1920.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

(10) The water is diverted from its source at a point N. 86° 30' W. 26,250 feet from

Remarks:

Spring No. 1 rises in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 17, and Nos. 2 and 3 rise in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 18, Tp. 23 N. Range 65 E. M.D.B. & M. and come together where works of the claimant are located; by cleaning out and channel from each of these springs to the point of diversion a sufficient flow is secured to be of service in watering stock on the range.

These springs were first used by Charles H. Odgers in 1900 for watering his sheep and cattle and when sold his range and land to Gasten Olsen who then sold the range and land to this claimant in 1906, and these springs have been used exclusively ever since by this claimant for watering his sheep.

Each year the claimant has cleaned out the springs and ditches and channels and repaired the reservoir so as to make a better place and better suited for the purpose of watering his sheep;

These are a part of a series of small springs and while none of them are sufficient to water a large herd of sheep, by combining them and ranging the sheep from one to the other sufficient water is obtained to water a good sized herd.
