Name of natural water course

Through Unnamed dam and reservoir.  
Name of ditch, pipe line, etc.

Albert Rosenlund, the undersigned, being first  
duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of  
water by him are full and correct to the  
best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(1) Name of claimant Albert Rosenlund,  
Address Schellbourne, County of White Pine,  
State of Nevada.

(2) The means of diversion employed is Dam and reservoir.  
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in 64 reservoir.  
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun 1900.  
and completed August, 1919.

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is  
Possessory right upon unsurveyed land of the United States.

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of  
County, at Page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 1800 sheep  
and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30 days during each  
of the following months April, May, June, July, August, September, October,  
and November.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

1800 head of sheep from 1900 to 1915;  
2000 head of sheep in 1916;  
2200 head of sheep in 1917;  
3000 head of sheep in each 1918 and 1919, and  
3600 head of sheep in 1920 were watered at this spring;

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

.20 cubic feet per second.  
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at a point N69° 10' W., 30,950 feet from  
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance  
the Southeast corner of Section 13, T. 23 N., R. 65 E.,  
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Note—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at a point in the SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Sec. 6, in TP.  
Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by title in same manner as under (10)  
23 N. Range 65 E/ M.D.B. & M.

Remarks:

This spring was first used by Charles H. Odgers in 1900 for watering his sheep and cattle and who sold his range and land to Casten Olsen who in turn sold his range and land to this applicant in 1906, and this spring has been used by this applicant exclusively ever since for his sheep.

Each year the applicant has cleaned out the spring and repaired the dam and reservoir so as to make it a better place and better suited for the purpose of watering his sheep.

This is one of a series of small springs and while none of them is sufficient to water a large herd, by combining them and ranging the sheep from one to the other sufficient water is secured to water a good sized herd.
