(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 150,
and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of entire year days during each
of the following months

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

150 to 250 cattle each year, and we and our predecessors in interest have watered bands of sheep here at times.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

.1 cubic feet per second.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at N 25° 0' W, 13,470 feet from the southeast corner of Section 29, T. 18N, R. 58E E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 5 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec 18, T 18N, R 58E, M. D. M.

Remarks: Map under this Amended Proof was filed in the State Engineer's office on November 11, 1922.

While the original use of the water was through small pools formed by dams in the channel of the stream, and from small reservoirs, this work has been improved by putting in 140 feet of wooden troughs. The waters of this spring flow in a northerly direction, and, at times, enter the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec 17, of the aforesaid township, which 40-acre tract is the property of The Adams-McGill Company.

On January 1922, original Proof of Appropriation on the waters of this spring was filed in the State Engineer's office showing this spring to be on NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec 17, of aforesaid township, and map of the location accompanied the proof. The survey was run in from the north and west. Government corners were not well-preserved in that country, and our company later had a survey run in from the south and east where Government corners were well shown.

Remarks:

This Amended Proof is made to conform the location of the spring with the map filed November 11, 1922, and is in accord with the survey last mentioned above. 20
