duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of
water by The Adams-McGill Company are full and correct to the
best of his knowledge and belief.

(1) Name of claimant The Adams-McGill Company

(2) The means of diversion employed is iron pipe and troughs
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in troughs
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun 1892
and completed 1921

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is
Patented land purchased from the State of Nevada - now owned
by the claimant

(6) The claimant's water right ~~has~~ (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of
County, at Page of Book of of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 1500,
and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 200 days during each
of the following months April to November

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

2,200 sheep and 150 cattle are now watered here from May 1st
to November 1st of each year.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

$\frac{1}{10}$ cubic feet per second.
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at N 14° 35' W, 9,280 feet from
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance
the Southeast corner of Section 33, T. 12N, R. 63 E.,
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 28, T 12N, R 63E.

Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: Livestock was watered at first in the channel
flowing from this spring; small dams were put across the
channel to create pools to hold the water. In September,
1921, the claimant laid 50 feet of $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe to con-
nect the spring with 100 feet of iron troughs 20 inches
in diameter. This spring is on land owned by the claimant,
and it is our understanding that the water does not flow
off our land.
