(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:  
cattle were watered at the springs for many years, and a  
band of sheep, approximately 3,000, has been watering at  
these springs from approximately April 1st to October 1st  
since 1904; the waters of these springs are also used for  
domestic purposes.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been  
 $\frac{1}{10}$  cubic feet per second.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at S. 71° 30' W., 11,600 feet from  
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance  
the northeast corner of Section 15, T. 18N., R. 62 E.,  
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 5 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

Remarks: The Adams-McGill Company and its grantors began using  
the waters of those springs by putting in small dams across the  
channel to form pools from which the live stock could drink.  
They, later, developed more water and put in a reservoir at the  
main spring and connected the reservoir, by means of an iron  
pipe, to 20 feet of wooden troughs 12 inches wide, and also con-  
tinued to use the channel with the pools in it.
