

PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES



From Willow Spring Name of natural water course

Through Willow Ditch Name of ditch, pipe line, etc.

E.C. Johnson, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by F.J. Winzell, and Kate Cookrill are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

E.C. Johnson is the lessee of the property owned by Winzell & Cookrill.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(1) Name of claimant F.J. Winzell and Kate Cookrill. Address Alpha, County of Eureka State of Nevada.

(2) The means of diversion employed is Ditch Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in Reservoir. Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun in the year 1875 and completed 1876, and every year thereafter cleaned out.

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is Vested right. Claimant and their predecessors in interest have used the water for the said spring for stockwatering purposes since 1875.

(6) The claimant's water right ~~has~~ (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of County, at Page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 300, and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30 days during each of the following months March until December of each and every year.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

At least 250 head of cattle each and every year.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

ONE cubic feet per second.

40 minors inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at a point N. 53° 15' W. 28700 feet from

True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

the corner of Section 15, T. 26-50, R. 50 E.,
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, 27-51

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, and the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of S. 17, T. 27 N. R. 50 E. Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: When surveyed will be the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, and the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17, T. 27. N. R. 50 E. M. D. B. & M.

Water has been used through ditches which have been maintained at the spring. It is now proposed to put in a trough which is to take the place of ditches and Reservoirs
