

PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES



From Rook Spring
Name of natural water course

Through Rook Spring
Name of ditch, pipe line, etc.

E.C. Johnson, the undersigned, being first duty sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by F.J. Winzell, and Kate Cockrill are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

E.C. Johnson is the lessee of the property owned by Winzell & Cockrill
If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(1) Name of claimant F.J. Winzell, and Kate Cockrill
Address Alph, County of Eureka
State of Nevada

(2) The means of diversion employed is Dam
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in Reservoir
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun in the year 1875 and completed in 1876.

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is Vested right. Claimant and their predecessors in interest have used the water from the said spring for stockwatering purposes since 1875.

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of County, at Page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 250 and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30 days during each of the following months March until December of each and every year.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

At least 250 cattle each and every year.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

ONE cubic feet per second.
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at N 47° 50' W 26014 feet feet from

the ~~SW~~ corner of Section 16, T. 27 N., R. 51 E.,
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Note—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at about 200 feet below Rock Spring in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 16
Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10) T. 27. N. 1

Remarks: Water has been used through ditches which have been maintained at the spring. It is now proposed to put in troughs which is to take the place of ditches & Reservoirs.

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
