(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: For stock and household purposes during the entire year.....

(21) The character of the soil is gravelly (Sandy, gravelly, loam). The soil needs 5 acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of 1.67 cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of 6 months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.
