

PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

Remarks: The waters flowing from this spring have been used for stock watering purposes for a period of extending from as far back as about 1885. Improvements in the nature of cleaning out the spring, walling it with rock and cleaning it out yearly have been completed. The water has been used for stock watering purposes each year since about 1885 by claimant and its predecessor in interest, W. W. Williams.
