

PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

(Amended) 01925

From Dry Spring No. 1
Through Unnamed pipe line and metal trough
Martin Fillippini, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by himself and predecessors are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

- (1) Name of claimant Martin Fillippini
Address Beowawe, County of Eureka, State of Nevada
(2) The means of diversion employed is Excavation and pipe line
(3) The water is impounded in Metal trough
(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun 1892 and completed 1892
(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is Government land
(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of County, at Page of Book of
(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of days during each of the following months May, June, July, August, September, October and November

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

About 75 head of cattle water at this spring and on account of

75 head water on said spring.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been
enough to water 75 head of cattle

(10) The water is diverted from its source at S 42°30' W 15843 feet from
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

(11) The works are located at same point as point of diversion.

1892 and owned it since 1900.
