


THE STATE OF NEVADA
PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR
STOCK WATERING PURPOSES



From Rocky Mountain Spring No. 1
Name of natural water course

Through one half inch pipe line

(2) The means of diversion employed is one half inch pipe line

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 50 head cattle
and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 210 days during
each of the following months ~~May, June, July, August, September, October and
November~~

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

About 50 head of cattle water at different springs and this

is approximation. They range in the vicinity of this spring and other springs and some cattle do not water at this spring each day on account of their roving disposition.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been enough

to water 50 head of cattle/cubic feet per second/

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at S. 72° 30' W. 27253 feet feet from

True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

the Southwest corner of Section, T. 24 N., R. 46 E.,

Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, or NW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 8, T. 24 N. R. 46 E.

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at same point as point of diversion.
