

AMENDED

PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES



From Unnamed spring in NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 Sec. 27, T. 21 N., R. 69 E., M.D.M. (The only spring or water source in said forty)

Through Name of ditch, pipe line, etc.

Steven Doutre, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by himself and his father (his predecessor in interest) are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(1) Name of claimant Steven Doutre Address Aurum County of White Pine State of Nevada

(2) The means of diversion employed is Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in reservoirs in channel below spring Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun about year 1895 and reservoirs and completed for watering sheep repaired and restored as occasion required.

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is tile to land is not claimed--open, public land.

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of County, at Page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant predecessor in interest during the first year was 2000 and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of thirty days during each of the following months June and July (sheep watered every other day, usually, during said two months period each year).

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:
2000 head each year in same way by my father (from whom I purchased all rights) until 1910, and thereafter by claimant, myself, the same number, approximately, each year to and including 1925.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been the entire flow during the two cubic feet per second months of each year so used.
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at _____ feet from the _____ corner of Section _____, T. _____, R. _____ E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at within the forty in which the spring is located and as described hereinabove.
Described within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: The spring (unnamed) is the only spring or water source used or usable within the forty described and was used solely by claimant's father for sheep watering between 1895 and 1910. In 1910 claimant bought from his father (Alfred Doure) all rights and thereafter claimant was the sole user of the waters of said spring for many years for stock watering. No other sheep or livestock generally were run by anyone else on that part of the public range, at least up to 1914 when John W. and Fred Henroid grazed some sheep on that portion of the range.

Claimant claims a vested right to the waters of said spring for sheep-watering uses from a time dating back to 1895.
