

PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

From Cherry Spring
Name of natural water course

Through Cherry Spring Ditch
Name of ditch, pipe line, etc.

Bernard Damele, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by Bernard, and Peter Damele are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(1) Name of claimant Bernard, and Peter Damele,

(2) The means of diversion employed is Reservoir and Ditch
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in Reservoir
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun 1898 and completed 1900

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is Possessory Interest

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of County, at Page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 150, and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30 days during each of the following months April to November

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

At least one hundred fifty head of cattle, horses, and sheep have been watered each and every year since the year 1898.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

$\frac{1}{2}$ cubic feet per second.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 12 T. 22 R. 49 E feet from

True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

the corner of Section, T., R., E.,
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of the $SE\frac{1}{4}$ pf Sec. 12 T. 22 N. R. 49 E.

Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: Claimant and his grantors have used all of the water flowing from the above named spring each and every year since 1898 for stock watering purposes.
