

PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

From East Creek Name of natural water course

J. H. Eager, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by The Adams-McGill Company Incorporated are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

(2) The means of diversion employed is Not diverted Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in not impounded Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun no construction necessary and completed

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is owned partly by The United States Government and partly by The Adams-McGill Co. Inc.

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Not recorded County, at Page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 200 cattle, and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of thirty (30) days during each of the following months April, May, June, July, August and September

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:
200 head of cattle from 1886 to 1897, and 100 head of cattle and 2500 sheep
from 1897 to and including 1924.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been
one fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$) cubic feet per second.
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at Not diverted feet from
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance
the corner of Section , T. , R. E.,
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at No work required
Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: The source of East Creek is located at a point N. 79 deg. 40' E,
18230 feet from S. W. cor. Sec. 20, T 19, R 65E, M. D. B. M. flows westerly through
portions of sections 23, 22, 21, 28 and 29 to the intake of a pipe line in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$
of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 29, T 19, R 65E.

The Adams-McGill Company Inc. and its predecessors, exclusively, have used all
the water necessary to water all the stock that could graze within ranging distance of
East Creek, continuously, since before 1886 and to 1925. Grazing right for the
season of 1925 was granted to others by the Forest officials.


