Remarks: The source of South Fork of North Creek is at a point N 63 degrees 50 minutes E, 19880 feet ^{from} the S.W. Cor Sec. 20, T 19, R 65E. The South Fork flows south-westerly across sections 14, 15, and 16 into North Creek in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 17, T 19, R 65E.

The Adams-McGill Company Inc. and its predecessors, exclusively, have used all the water necessary to water all the stock that could graze within ranging distance of the South Fork of North Creek, since before 1886 and to 1924.

Grazing right for the seasons of 1924 and 1925 were granted to others by the X Forest officials.
