- (2) The means of diversion employed Ditch  
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.
- (3) The date of the survey of ditch, canal, or pipe line was August 1919
- (4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun 1872  
 and completed May 1924
- (5) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as originally constructed were: Width on bottom 3  
 feet, width on top 3 feet, depth 1 1/2 feet, on a grade of 10/0 feet per thousand feet.
- (6) The conduit has ~~been~~ enlarged.  
Note—If enlargement or extension of ditch was made, supply information under (7) and (8)
- (7) The work of enlargement of the ditch or canal was begun year of 1917  
 and completed May 1924
- (8) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as enlarged are: Width on bottom three feet, width on top three feet, depth 1 1/2 feet, on a grade of 10/0 feet per thousand feet.
- (9) The claimant is ~~is not~~ an owner in the above-described conduit.

- (10) The nature of the title to the land for which the water right is claimed is I purchased the land from the Cambrian Copper Company
