

PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES



From HEADWATERS SPRING CAMP VALLEY CREEK.

R. H. WINDER, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by the MURRAY SHEEP COMPANY are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

(10) The water <sup>raises</sup> is diverted from its source at N. 30° 10' W., 2795 feet from the South (1/4) one-quarter corner of Section 23, T. 6 N., R. 68 E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.


