PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

Jas B. Wilson, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by James Wilson and Geo. T. A. Wilson are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

This affidavit is made by James Wilson on behalf of himself and co-partner and co-claimant Geo. T. A. Wilson

(1) Name of claimant James Wilson and Geo. T. A. Wilson
Address Wilson's Ranch near Arden, County of Clark
State of Nevada

(2) The means of diversion employed is Dam and reservoir at Spring
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in dam and reservoir; dam of loose rock and gravel
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun in 1887
and completed 1887

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is unentered government land

(6) The claimant's water right ~~was~~ (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of _____ County, at page _____ of Book _____ of _____

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 800
and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 360 days during each of the following months each month of the year

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:
A band of Cattle ranging from 500 to 800 head

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been One miner inch cubic feet per second.
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at about 2500 ft SW feet
from the NE corner of Section 1, T. 21 S, R. 5 E,
E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at Sec 1, T. 21 S, Range 58 E. M.D.M.
Describe as within a 40 acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: Claimants have had a band of cattle on the range using this spring since about the year 1887, operating as James B. Wilson & sons, but since death of James B. Wilson, Sr. in 1906 claimants have maintained cattle on the same range using waters from this spring as Wilson Bros. Their cattle are and have been the only cattle on the range and using this spring; The spring was dug out and cleaned out and reservoir and dam made in 1887, and has been cleaned out and dug out and dam and reservoir maintained and repaired each year thereafter. Cattle of claimants use the entire flow of about one inch at the dam and reservoir at the springs
