

PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

From Foley's Springs (Fuo) Name of natural water source.
Through Ditch Name of ditch, pipe line, etc.
Wm. H. Sweeney, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by himself are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(2) The means of diversion employed is Ditch & reservoir Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in Ditch Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun 1887 by Mr. Foley, claimant's grantor, and completed 1887.

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is Quitclaim Deed, in year 1890 about.

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Eureka County, at page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 150 and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of all days during each of the following months entire year.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows: Average of 150 head.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been 1/40 cubic feet per second.  
40 minims inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at Springs feet  
probably unsurveyed true bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance  
from the probably unsurveyed corner of Section \_\_\_\_\_, T. \_\_\_\_\_, R. \_\_\_\_\_,  
E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Note—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 5 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at unsurveyed  
Describe as within a 40 acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: These springs are located in Rye Grass Canyon about 1/2 miles from Sweeney's house on the road to Monitor Valley, about 3/4 of a mile west of Sweeney's Lower Pasture. The springs are surrounded by a clump of willows. Sweeney's house is on Sweeney's Ranch about 40 miles S.W. of the town of Eureka, Eureka County, Nevada.
