duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by appropriation improvement and user are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

(2) The means of diversion employed is by pipe line from spring into trough  
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in through  
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun in the spring of 1875  
and completed afterwards in the Spring of 1875, and reconstructed in 1900 as the spring and improvements now are and as herein described.

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is appropriation improvement of spring, construction of pipe line from Spring to troughs and continuous user for a period from 1875 to date inclusive.

(6) The claimant's water right was (~~was not~~) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of White Pine County, at page \_\_\_\_\_ of Book \_\_\_\_\_ of The records are not available as the said records were destroyed by fire about or more than 20 years ago.

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 30  
and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of all of the days during each of the following months January, February, March, April, May, June, July, August, September, November and December of each year.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:  
1876 about 30 animals; 1877 about 50; from 1878 until 1880 about 80. from 1880 until 1890 about 60; from 1890 until 1900 about 150 from 1900 until 1910 inclusive about 100; from 1910 until and including the date hereof about 150.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been about  
one gallon every two minutes cubic feet per second.  
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at a point 2184 feet  
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance  
from the South West corner of Section 7, T. 18, R. 55,  
E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Note—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at a point in the S.E. 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of said sec. 7, T. 18  
Describe as within a 40 acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: The Springs lie more exactly by 84° 30' E. 2184 feet  
from the SW. Cr. of Sec 7, T. 18, R. 55 E. M. D.M.  
The improvements cost about \$200. The Spring is and  
continuously since 1902 been enclosed by a substantial  
fence. The Spring was enlarged by excavation. The pipe  
line is about 16 feet long and consists of an iron pipe  
about 2 inches in diameter. Diligent search has been  
made for the recorded water right, but the same cannot  
be found. The enclosure made by the fencing is the  
corral of the affiant. The water not used, if any, is  
not confined. But no excess water flows from tank  
and all of said water is necessary and used for  
stock purposes and has been necessary and used  
for stock purposes from and including the year 1876  
until and including the date hereof. A survey of said Spring  
is herewith sent attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and reference thereto is hereby made.
