(21) Remarks: The ditch was first surveyed by L. H. Taylor for Charles Polkinghorne, deceased husband of affiant; in 1904 the land and ditch were surveyed by Henry W. Newby for said Charles Polkinghorne, and it was understood that Newby had filed the water-right with the County Recorder of Humboldt County, Nevada, on the completion of the survey. Affiant cannot find any record in the office of said Recorder covering the water-right.
