are full and correct to the best of his
knowledge and belief.

and completed by claimant 1905.

(19) The map provided by the State Engineer and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditch lines or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: Stock watering and domestic purposes.

(21) Remarks: This water is spread over the meadow and produces crops of hay which are harvested annually. A portion of the land is plowed and cultivated for the purposes above mentioned. Water has been used continuously since the first year the land was irrigated and a right is claimed with that priority.
