duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by
himself are full and correct to the best of his
knowledge and belief.

(19) The map provided by the State Engineer and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditch lines or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation:.....~~Water used for watering stock and irrigation~~..... only.

(21) Remarks: The flow of water from the Old Bennett spring does not exceed one miner's inch on a basis of 40 miner's inches to a second foot. The water in its natural flow during the irrigating season does not reach the land in question on account of the flow being so small and the distance too great. The manner of use by claimant is that the water from the spring is stored in the reservoir shown on the map, for several days and then it is allowed to flow in a large stream for one or two hours and thus utilize all of the water by having a flow large enough to reach the land. There is no other claimant to any of the water of Old Bennett spring.
