

PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

From Tank Springs, Situate on the Northerly slope of Clover Mountain, Lincoln County, Nevada. Name of natural water source.

Through Open cut and ditch Name of ditch, pipe line, etc.

Lamond C. Woods, the undersigned, being first

duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by himself are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(2) The means of diversion employed is Open Cut and Ditch Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in Earth dams Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun Prior to 1875 and and completed Prior to 1900

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is Possessory and the land upon which the said Springs are located is unsurveyed and a corral for stock is erected at said Spring and used by claimant.

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of County, at page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 250 and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30 days during each of the following months May, June, July, August, September, October, November and December.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows: 250 from 1875 to 1880; 500 from 1880 to 1890; 1200 from 1890 to 1900 and the same number as last stated from 1900 to 1909.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been One fortieth of a fortieth of a cubic feet per second.
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at Spring on unsurveyed land feet
True bearing to nearest 6 minutes distance
from the _____ corner of Section _____, T. 6 S, R. 69,
E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

(11) The works are located at and adjacent to said Tank Spring which is situate
Describe as within a 40 acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks:-- on the northerly slope of Clover Mountain about 12 miles South of Barkley and about three miles ~~southeastly~~ from sheep springs in what is known as Tank wash and at a point near Wood's saw mill, in said Coutny of Lincoln.

Improvements: Open Cut 50 feet long 3 ft. wide and 2 ft. deep and a stock corral built of lumber slabe, with an average flow of 12 gallons per minute.

Remarks: This claimant and his predecessors in interest have been in the open, notorious, uninterrupted, peaceable, and exclusive possession of said Willow Springs, using the water thereof continuously for more than thirty five years under a claim of right so to do against all persons whomsoever, and that any and all improvements made on said spring in the development of the waters thereof and adjacent improvements were made by and at the expense of this claimant and his predecessors.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 18, Chapter XVIII, Statutes of 1907, has determined the priority and amount of such appropriation as follows:

Description of irrigated land works:-

Water is diverted from the spring by means of an open cut or ditch 50 feet long, 3 feet wide and two feet deep, and is impounded by means of earth dams.

Description of use other than irrigation :-

Stock-watering and domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the period between May 1st. and Dec. 31st. of each year, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired, and is dependent upon beneficial use.
