PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

From MC LAIN SPRINGS situate on the Northerly slope of Clover Mountain Lincoln County, Nevada. Name of natural water source.

Through board flume and wooden trough. Name of ditch, pipe line, etc.

Lamond C. Woods, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by himself are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

(2) The means of diversion employed is Wooden flume and Wooden Trough Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in Wooden trough Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun prior to 1875 and completed prior to 1890

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is Possessory and the land upon which said springs are situate is unsurveyed.

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of County, at page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 250 and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30 days during each of the following months May, June, July, August, September, October, November and December.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows: 250 from 1875 to 1880, 500 from 1880 to 1890 and 1200 from 1890 to 1900 and the same number as last mentioned from 1900 to 1909
